**REAL ESTATE LAND APPRAISAL BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES  
IS FOCUS OF APRIL 29 SFWMD WORKSHOP**  
*Minority Businesses Encouraged To Attend*

The South Florida Water Management District will hold a free public workshop on April 29 to discuss real estate land appraisal needs and requirements for acquiring land as part of the Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Plan (CERP). The meeting will begin at 9 a.m. at SFWMD headquarters, 3301 Gun Club Road, in West Palm Beach.

Florida state-certified and designated appraisers are invited to attend to learn more about the long-term federal/state initiative to restore and revitalize the Everglades ecosystem, and the potential real estate business opportunities it provides. Minority businesses are especially encouraged to participate in the informative session.

At the workshop, District staff will present an overview of the Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Plan, outline the District's appraisal standards and minimum qualifications, provide land acquisition information and discuss other related topics.
