WINSBERG FARMS DESIGN AGREEMENT SIGNING CEREMONY TO TAKE PLACE THURSDAY IN DELRAY BEACH

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – A signing ceremony for the Winsberg Farms Design Agreement between the Department of the Army and Palm Beach County will be held Thursday, January 3 at 11 a.m.

The event will be held at the Wakodahatchee Wetlands located at 13026 Jog Road, in Delray Beach, Fla.

The ceremony marks the implementation of the Corps' first county-sponsored Everglades restoration project which will convert 175 acres of farmland into wetlands. Water used in the project will come from the Southern Region Water Reclamation facility. The design phase of the project is expected to take two and a half years.

The ceremony is being held this week to coincide with the Everglades Coalition meeting being held in Fort Lauderdale.
