WORKSHOP ON PROGRAMMATIC REGULATIONS REQUIREMENTS FOR EVERGLADES RESTORATION TO BE HELD FEBRUARY 11

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The public is invited to participate in a workshop conducted by the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers regarding restoration activities required by the Programmatic Regulations for the Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Plan (CERP). The Programmatic Regulations establish the framework for guiding CERP implementation.

The workshop will be held on Wednesday, February 11, 2004, from 6:30 to 9:00 p.m. at the SFWMD Main Auditorium, 3301 Gun Club Road, West Palm Beach, FL 33406. The meeting will also be broadcast live on the Internet at the following web address:
