JACK MALOY JOINS SFWMD TO HEAD THE COMPREHENSIVE EVERGLADES RESTORATION PLAN AND EVERGLADES CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Former South Florida Water Management District Executive Director Jack Maloy returns to the District [April 4 to help manage](#) the largest public works project in the world. Maloy will be responsible for the day-to-day management of the \$7.8 billion Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Plan (CERP), a federal and state joint project designed to restore and revitalize the Everglades. He will also oversee the ongoing Everglades Construction Project, which sets the cornerstone for Everglades restoration, [including](#) the construction and operation of six stormwater treatment areas, or STAs, that reduce phosphorous levels entering the Everglades.

District [Deputy](#) Executive Director [Joe Schweigart](#) describes Maloy's expertise as [highly beneficial in successfully moving forward with](#) Everglades restoration. "Jack is a tremendously talented individual whose passion for his work as a water resource manager is well known in many circles," Schweigart said. "His presence will now solidly round out our Public Works management team."

Maloy joined the District in 1965 as [an Engineer in the Hydrology and Hydraulics Division](#), where he worked until being named Director of Planning in 1970. The next year, Maloy was promoted to Assistant Executive Director. He was then named Executive Director for the District in 1975, where he remained until 1984. Maloy's most recent position is Assistant Department Director of Water Resources for the St. Johns River Water Management District in Palatka.

"I am very excited to return to the South Florida Water Management District and to [have the opportunity to be involved with the challenges of](#) a restoration project of unprecedented size," Maloy said. "Managing and working with a group of talented individuals committed to Everglades restoration will truly be an honor for me."
